Footnotes

GET SERIOUS vied inside from the outset, dueled with EL COMMODORE turning for home and dug in determinedly inside to prevail. EL COMMODORE vied outside for command, briefly put a head in front at the furlong marker and dug in gamely outside to the finish. QUEEN'SPLATEKITTEN raced off the pace, moved up into contention passing the quarter pole, angled out and was up late for the show. LUBASH stalked outside a rival, came three wide into the lane and finished evenly. YUMMY WITH BUTTER pulled early along the inside, tracked on the rail and lacked a stretch response. MONUMENT HILL raced off the pace, angled out and failed to rally.
