TAP GOLD hung four wide into the clubhouse turn, raced well placed outside, lodged a bid on the final turn and reached the pacesetter in midstretch then wore that one down in the run to the wire. SEEKING AN ANGEL saved ground while setting the pace, responded willingly in the drive but could not resist the top one. FABULOUS NOTEBOOK lunged out some at the break to be away a bit slowly, saved ground into the far turn, swung out for the drive and finished willingly. GIPSY LIMITS prompted the pace outside and weakened in the drive. MUTUAL FUND in close briefly between rivals entering the clubhouse turn, raced outside, was five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MIDNIGHT MILE raced near the inside and lacked a response then tired through the lane and was eased up late.
