VALUE PLAYER bothered at the start to be away slowly, raced between rivals into the far turn, challenged for the lead nearing the quarter pole and prevailed following a prolonged drive. PAMPERED SIR stumbled at the start, set the pace just off the inside and battled between rivals through the stretch and held gamely to the wire. OLE RUGGED CROSS well placed while saving ground, lodged a bid turning for home and loomed a solid threat but was not quite good enough. JAZZ FOREVER saved ground and lacked the needed rally. HADDENFIELD came out at the start, raced five wide turning for home and lacked a rally. LIBERTARIAN raced between rivals into the far turn and lacked a rally. FARRAGOTS FOLLIES chased early, raced three wide turning for home and tired. HARBOR RIDGE tracked early, raced just off the inside and had little left turning for home.
