**Footnotes**

MAX HAZARD was bumped after the start, raced close up inside, bid three wide at the quarter pole, took over and drew clear, driving. WIDE OPEN ROAD settled off the pace, advanced outside on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and finished well outside. HOT DEPOSIT was fractious in the gate, dueled outside and saved the show. NEATKNOCK had a three wide and weakened. THE MAN CAN STEP was bumped after the start, saved ground and lacked a rally. SONZUL dueled inside and tired. THIS CAT SWINGS did not factor. TWISTED HEART raced off the rail and failed to respond. AIN'TSUPERSTITIOUS was bumped after the start, chased between and faded.
