MISS TAPIT shifted out some early to avoid crowding, raced five wide into the lane and challenged for the lead in the stretch then proved best. DIMPLES bid four wide on the final turn and reached the front at the top of the lane then continued on willingly while no match late to the top one. MISS SPEED DATING trailed early and off the inside, moved in on the final turn, eased back out in upper stretch and offered a late gain. GINNY G in good position while saving ground, advanced between rivals passing the sixteenth pole and finished willingly inside. YEOHO tracked early, prompted the issue on the final turn between foes and weakened in the drive. CHEER N SHOUT bumped twice nearing the end of the chute then up close, bid three wide on the second turn and tired in the drive. PORVOO set the pace inside and weakened in the drive. WIDE EYED WONDER bumped twice with a rival nearing the end of the chute and in the process appeared to try and savage that foe, raced rank along the inside and lacked a bid.
