WITH ANTICIPATION stalked the lead just outside the pacesetter, made his bid three wide around the early leader on the final turn, brushed with Denon through the upper stretch then dueled to a short lead and finished unyieldingly. DENON rated close to the pace, made his bid angling five wide around the top contenders on the final turn, was in tight quarters brushing With Anticipation to the inside and Sarafan to his outside through the upper stretch, dueled the remainder but was outfinished. SARAFAN raced unhurriedly just off the rail, rallied six wide through the final turn, made contact with Denon in the upper stretch then lugged in dueling outside through the stretch and leveled out in the final yards. SUANCES (GB) firmly rated the lead just off the rail, dueled inside through the upper stretch then weakened the final sixteenth. DEPUTY STRIKE raced unhurriedly, made a bid three wide through the final turn but was empty for the drive. CRASH COURSE raced unhurriedly then showed no response through the final turn. BLAZING FURY raced unhurriedly then tired while saving ground.
