CORINTHIAN'S JEWEL raced off the pace inside, came three wide between rivals into the stretch, closed willingly and kicked away. BIG KICK raced off the pace, rallied on rail in upper stretch, brushed the rail and bumped with COULDAWOULDASHOULD at the furlong marker and then closed well for second. UR raced off the pace, came three wide into the lane and rallied mildly outside. JOEY WHISPERS dueled outside and weakened. COULDAWOULDASHOULD dueled inside, weakened and was bumped at the eighth pole. ART CLASS raced off the pace inside, bid three wide at the quarter pole and weakened. WAR BOY chased, moved up inside on the far turn and lacked a winning bid. OPPY was outrun.
