RAGING DAOUST tracked inside, bid two wide turning for home, rallied outside of BIG SUR and got the nod after a long drive. BIG SUR set the pace on the inside, inched away turning for home, dug in gamely when challenged and just missed. CSABA raced off the pace, had a ground saving trip, came out late and rallied mildly. DISCREET DANCER raced four wide into the clubhouse turn, stalked outside, came three wide into the stretch and closed belatedly near the rail. LUCY'S BOB BOY was a step slow at the break, moved up to press the pace, came three wide into the stretch and weakened. SMALL TOWN TALK raced three wide early and failed to threaten. PRIVATE TALE hopped at the start, raced three wide early and did not factor. BOWMAN'S BEAST raced three wide early, then between rivals, chased three wide and faded.
