TWIST AND POP prompted the early issue, moved to the front approaching the quarter pole, responded when asked in earnest then was outfinished. DANCINANDSINGIN set the early pace, saved ground and weakened in the drive. PLEASANT PASTURES in good position early from the outside, flattened out nearing the stretch. EARTHQUAKE RIDE broke out some, raced just off the inside in the run down the backstretch then came up empty when asked on the final turn. LUCKY WISH lacked a rally.
