Footnotes

STARDUST SKIER angled toward the inside while rating a clear lead then widened through the stretch under a moderately aggressive hand ride. POWERFUL TWO PUNCH rated off the early pace toward mid track, gave chase into the lane, proved no match for the winner but was best for place. MIA PUNCHER no speed early, advanced in mid track on the turn and finished evenly. SPECTACULAR DANCE broke out bumping Almalu hard and caused her rider to lose his irons, quickly recovered advancing to contention along the rail, lacked room into the turn, angled six wide nearing the quarter pole, closed and finished evenly. NANKOWEAP showed no speed widest then no rally. DON'T TELL HARRY rated just off the pace about the four path then faded in the stretch. ALMALU was jostled hard at the start and checked from between horses on the chute. ASHLEY'SSUMMERGOLD was kept close to the early pace inside but faded entering the stretch. JORDAN'S ROSE broke in bumping Almalu and was herself bumped off stride then tired on the turn.
