TURBO COMPRESSOR set a comfortable pace on the inside, responded when asked turning for home, sprinted clear and was kept to the task. AIR SUPPORT was a bit fractious in the gate, settled off the pace in the two path, moved up three wide on the backside, rallied outside and was clearly second best. AL KHALI pulled in the early stages racing along the inside, continued to track on the rail, was steadied and lost position at the quarter pole, then rallied mildly outside. FREUD'S HONOUR stalked the pace, raced between rivals on the final turn and finished evenly inside. SLIM SHADEY (GB) raced off the pace outside a rival, came four wide into the lane and gained mildly. BRILLIANT SPEED raced off the pace inside, came three wide into the lane and failed to rally. ELDAAFER settled in the two path, chased between foes on the backside and tired.
