### Footnotes

ROYAL CURRIER tracked early, raced three wide turning for home while challenging for the lead, reached the front in the stretch under left handed pressure and drew clear a sixteenth out then held to the wire. RAGING SIX trailed and inside to the lane, moved out in upper stretch and finished strongly. JUSTIN PHILLIP stumbled at the start, chased four wide on the turn and gained some late for a share. THE HUNK moved up inside through the early stages and reached the front, saved ground and vied for command then kept on through the stretch run while not good enough. POSEIDON'S WARRIOR vied for the lead, raced in the two path on the turn and weakened in the drive. J J'S LUCKY TRAIN never far back and just off the rail turning for home, lacked the needed bid.
