BETTY'S STAR scrimmaged for the lead along the rail, conceded the lead and switched to the two path on the turn, took the lead entering the stretch and edged clear late. GRANDMA PAT well back early, made a bid for the lead three wide on the far turn, entered the stretch six wide and finished with a flurry for place. MS VERSATILITY vied for command early while two wide, was hard used to keep pace two wide on the far turn, entered the stretch two wide and found her best strides way too late. OUT OF LAUGHS chased four wide early, made a bid for the lead three wide on the final turn, loomed boldly four wide into the stretch and finished well late. PIZZAZZ dueled three wide early, took command entering the far turn, lost the lead at the 1/4 pole and tired. ELEGANT APRIL chased two wide early, checked very hard entering the far turn and lost his momentum, made another run midway on the turn, lacked running room in upper stretch and finished well in the latter stages. LONG DISTANCE hesitated at the start, was outrun early, was forced steady sharply entering the turn, made her best strides midway on the turn, entered the stretch six wide and finished with good energy. SHARP LIL SHANANIE tracked along the rail early, lost ground when lacking running room for the beginning of the last turn to mid stretch and was under mild urging late.
