D'PART reached the front soon after the start, saved ground and lost the lead on the turn, regained the edge in upper stretch and drove clear. DANCE MASTER pressed the early issue, moved to the front on the turn then was no match in the drive while saving the place. SKYRUNNER just off the early leaders, was gaining some late. WHATA BRAINSTORM broke slowly, was outrun early then finished with good energy. MAGICAL MADNESS stayed outside and lacked the needed response. CHANCELLOR M. H. between rivals into the turn while forwardly placed, lacked a bid. BELT DRIVEN lacked a bid. TWO TOUR was steadied into the turn dropping back some then offered little thereafter. BETWEEN THE SHEIKS saved ground and lacked a response. MIDRIFF was no factor.
