**Footnotes**

PROFITEROLES up close while between rivals, bid between foes in the lane and finished well while edging clear late. BET ON THE BLUE prompted the early issue, moved to the front turning for home and continued on gamely to the wire. CHECK POINT never far back, raced four wide into the lane and gradually gained while needing more late. JUST LIVIN A DREAM up close early outside, lodged a three wide bid on the final turn, chased and was not good enough. MS. SHORT POCKETS up close while saving ground, raced between rivals late and lacked the needed response. AARONESS saved ground into the far turn, raced between foes late and lacked the needed bid. CHOICE PLAY trailed then offered a late gain from the outside. REPREIVE rated on the pace, saved ground and responded when asked on the final turn then weakened in the drive.
