**Footnotes**

BEAT THE BLUES tracked inside, came through on the rail to take over at the three eighths marker and drew clear in upper stretch. CHEROKEE LAKE stalked early, saved ground on the turn, finished well and was clear for the place. BIBLE BELT chased three wide, came four wide into the lane and rallied mildly. SHE WEARS THE BEST dueled inside, raced between rivals into the stretch and stayed on for a share. I'M WITH YOU was outrun early and made a mild gain inside. UNBRIDLED BABE dueled three wide and tired. LADY SYMPHONY raced between rivals and lacked a rally. VESTED IN TOWN raced off the inside and failed to threaten. NO DOUBT chased outside and tired. IVY WALK was off slowly and did not factor. DON'T ASK THE DOC dueled between rivals and faded.
