D'LUCCI GIRL unhurried early, lodged a three wide bid on the final turn and finished well while drawing clear late. NO MO MAGIC broke out and prompted the early issue, moved to the front on the final turn and battled through the lane then held gamely to the wire. CATREIGN set the early pace inside, responded when headed and regained the edge in the stretch then held on well while not good enough. THEWIFEDOESNTKNOW just off the inside early, saved ground on the final turn, stayed inside for the drive and finished willingly. BOOM TOWN SALLY up close early, saved ground to the lane and lacked the needed response. JULIE'S TWIN CHARM moved out turning for home and lacked a rally. MAGGIE'S BOOTS raced near the inside on the last turn and lacked the needed bid. BELLE DORADA bumped at the start and a bit rank briefly into the backstretch, raced well placed then tired in the drive. SPEEDY SWEETY saved ground into the backstretch, raced outside into the lane and lacked a bid.
