CALL FIRST vied for the lead from just off the inside, held the advantage turning for home and finished gamely to prevail. DANNHAUSER broke slowly, lodged a four wide bid nearing the quarter pole, challenged for the lead in the stretch then continued on gamely while unable to get up. BIG SUR well placed early, lodged a three wide bid nearing the quarter pole, was between foes through upper stretch while looming a solid threat then was not good enough. TENTH WAVE raced five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. WEAWE IT TO ME saved ground into the far turn, was just off the rail into the lane and lacked the needed response. CANDY MINE saved ground and lacked a rally. RHYTHM ON HEIR saved ground and vied for the lead then tired through the lane. SINORICE bobbed at the start, pressed three wide into the backstretch, chased and weakened into the lane.
