**Footnotes**

CIMPLY SAVIO outrun early, improved her position nicely along the backside, came out sharply on the far turn and forced traffic trouble, had a full head of steam going four wide into the stretch and mowed down FINANCE MAJOR late. FINANCE MAJOR was the controlling pace in her, was put to the whip on the turn to keep on the inside, opened a clear advantage in the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. CROWN AND WATER outrun early, found her best strides on the rail on the turn, took up sharply in upper stretch, regained her strides and finished well for third. MISS MOMBO QUEEN was under a hard hold early while attending to the pace two wide, was asked for her best on the turn and ran even late. LOVE IN RIO chased two wide early, moved up nicely three wide on the backside was bumped hard on the far turn and failed to recover from there. NICOLE'S PENNY prompted the pace early two wide and failed to make her presence felt on the far turn. EXPENSIVE COFFEE tracked three wide early, was bumped hard on the far turn, entered the stretch five wide and tired. TOO VICTORIOUS rank early and was outrun. GO IT ALONE showed little. CORY'S COMET was a forward factor and tired.
