VIOLON SACRE pulled inside on the clubhouse turn, saved ground, moved up three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and closed strongly outside for the win. BANROCK raced between foes early on, saved ground on the far turn, came through on the rail, took a short lead and dug in gamely to the finish. WHATSTHESCRIP (IRE) raced between foes off the pace, saved ground on the far turn and finished well inside. MINNIE PUNT was content to trail, made a five wide run on the far turn and flattened out. AT THE DISCO stalked the pace, bid three wide on the turn and weakened. SUNSHINE RAMBLER raced three wide early, between rivals on the far turn and lacked a rally. ENCAUSTIC set the pace, came off the rail entering the turn and tired. PAMPERED SIR tracked inside and gave way.
