PERFECT OFFICER raced off the pace inside, advanced between rivals on the turn, rallied outside and wore down VARSITY in the final strides. VARSITY rushed up the rail leaving the chute, vied inside, shook clear and dug in gamely inside. JU JITSU JAX chased between foes, three wide on the turn and rallied mildly outside. TRIPLE E was off a bit slow, advanced on the turn, angled out and rallied mildly. RUSTY CHARLIE vied outside, chased and weakened. ISTISHAARY chased inside and lacked a rally. ZIP QUIK settled off the rail and failed to respond. SOUTHERN DANGER chased three wide and tired.
