### Footnotes

ROSE'S TURN well placed early, lodged a bid on the final turn and dueled through the lane then edged clear late. TOUGH MARKET up close early, moved to the front on the final turn, battled into midstretch then continued on willingly. AURIC GIRL saved ground to the far turn, raced three wide turning for home and chased then needed more. HOLLIE'S HOLIDAY vied early inside, saved ground into the far turn, moved just off the inside and tired in the drive. SNEAKIN UP trailed and five wide turning for home, lacked the needed rally. BELLEZZA ROSSO stumbled at the break and a bit wide into the clubhouse turn, chased and raced four wide turning for home then tired. DEVILOFANARGUMENT raced outside into the clubhouse turn and was headstrong, had the saddle slip, moved in while clear into the backstretch, continued to save ground and weakened through the lane.
