SOARING STOCKS prompted the early issue, moved to the front while being rated passing the quarter pole, responded when asked in the lane and drew off under urging then was allowed to coast nearing the wire. CARSON BANDIT gradually advanced inside through the early stages to reach the front, saved ground throughout and was no match to the top one while holding the place. PROMISING ED lodged a bid between rivals on the turn and needed more in the drive. SOLID GUY outside into the turn, raced in the five path into the stretch and lacked the needed response. NIGHT OFFICER saved ground on the turn, lacked a clear path passing the sixteenth pole, was angled to the rail and gained some. TRUEAMERICANPRIDE well placed while saving ground, lacked the needed bid. ALKE JOHN raced outside and lacked a rally. MY ITALIAN EX chased three wide, raced in the four path entering the lane, came in some leaving the furlong grounds and weakened. TROUBLE IN DODGE failed to menace.
