BOMBAST up close early inside, eased out slightly on the turn and reached the front passing the eighth pole then drew out late, a driving winner. THE HUNK broke out slightly, advanced through the opening stages and drew clear, was rated into the turn, raced off the rail into the stretch then was no match late to the top one while second best. IRISH WINDSONG lodged a bid inside on the turn and chased into midstretch then was best of the rest. CAMP PARTY bobbled slightly at the start, raced well placed three wide into the turn and lacked the needed bid then tired in the drive. PRIVATE WISH bumped between rivals at the start, raced near the rail on the turn and lacked a rally. DEWEST saved ground and lacked a bid. NICKY RED broke in some, raced outside into the turn and lacked a response. AMEN CORNER vied for the lead through the opening stages, chased into the turn and tired through the lane.
