CATY'S QUEST stalked the pace from the outside, took the lead nearing the quarter pole then drew off through the stretch under steady asking. AMERICAN FIRE advanced to the lead and rated the early pace, was caught nearing the quarter pole, couldn't match strides with the winner and settled for second best. IMAGES IN JADE broke inward then showed no speed, ran four wide through the turn and passed tiring rivals in the stretch. AYRES HALL stalked the pace on the rail, dropped back while under pressure through the turn, came off the rail entering the stretch and was empty for the drive. ALLONDRA was pinched back and steadied at the start after coming out a step slow, saved ground through the turn then had no significant bid. GOLDEN HUSSY was squeezed at the start, used off the pace then tired. QUIET SPLENDOR broke outward then ran a dull race, drifting out through the stretch. NOBLE SEARCH raced just off the early pace toward the outside, faded through the turn then gave way in the stretch.
