ATOMIC RAIN outside into the far turn and four wide passing the quarter pole, reached the front in upper stretch and drove clear. DESPITE THE ODDS always a factor while inside, moved to the front on the final turn, battled into upper stretch then was no match to the top one while holding the place. PAPA CLEM broke a bit slowly then in close, stumbled soon after the start, pulled while near the rail on the clubhouse turn, continued to save ground and advanced along the rail into the lane then lacked the needed late response. OMNISCIENT trailed into the far turn, raced five wide into the stretch and offered a late gain. NOWHERE TO HIDE raced four wide turning for home, drifted in some nearing the sixteenth pole and lacked a solid bid. LORD JUSTICE close up early, lodged a three wide bid on the final turn and challenged for the lead then weakened in the drive. SANTANA SIX well placed early, raced near the rail into the far turn and lacked the needed response then tired. RAPID REDUX broke a bit slowly and rushed up to set the pace, raced just off the rail and had little left turning for home.
