Footnotes

VINDICAT steadied along in the run down the backstretch and into the turn, moved outside and raced five wide into the lane, drifted in late and finished gamely while prevailing at the wire. CALDRON set the pace and raced off the rail into the stretch, edged away a furlong out then just missed. EON up close early and just off the inside, raced along the rail through the lane and finished willingly. OLYMPIC PEGASUS chased outside on the turn, was four wide into the lane and lacked the needed late response. TALK TO NICK chased three wide, was steadied late and weakened. SUNDAY BLITZ saved ground and weakened into the lane. GAMBLER'S RISK bobbled at the start and lacked a bid. The stewards posted the inquiry sign and the rider of TALK TO NICK lodged a claim of foul against the winner for late interference but no change was made.
