PRIMAL PASSION saved ground and vied for command then weakened in the drive. FOREWARNED trailed early, raced outside into the stretch and was gaining late. OLIVIA JO gained some ground late outside. WILL'S GAL raced forwardly placed to the stretch and tired. LUVINHERISEASI saved ground on the turn and weakened in the drive. APRIL MORNING well placed early from the outside, tired. E BAR EL close up early and outside on the turn, raced along the inside through the lane and flattened out. MARQUET RATE was through early.
