

DANCE HALL DAYS in a bit close at the start, raced near the inside turning for home, advanced between rivals leaving the furlong grounds and finished gamely to prevail. HARTIGAN lodged a bid on the final turn, raced between foes in midstretch and finished gamely. AWESOME I AM was asked for run into the far turn, reached the front passing the quarter pole and yielded grudgingly. ASK THE MOON three wide into the clubhouse turn, prompted the issue, inherited the lead briefly on the final turn and weakened in the drive. INVENTIVE advanced on the last turn, raced outside while looming a threat in midstretch but could not sustain the needed momentum. SAKI TO ME saved ground while well placed early and weakened. BETTY IS READY in a bit close at the start, saved ground on the final turn and lacked a rally. BREAK POINT came out some at the start and between rivals into the clubhouse turn, moved out and raced well placed then lacked the needed response and tired nearing the lane. SNOWY ELEGANCE in a bit close leaving the gate, lacked a rally. CHARMING stumbled at the start, set the early pace inside then took a bad step and was pulled up on the final turn then vanned off. The stewards posted the inquiry sign concerning CHARMING prior to declaring the original order of finish official.
