PIAZZA DI SPAGNA (CHI) showed the way to the lane, widened into midstretch then maintained a safe margin to the wire. MUMTAZ (FR) trailed until nearing the top of the lane then finished well outside and earned the place. ARTY'SVIRGINIAGIRL raced between rivals in upper stretch then finished willingly along the inside. LAURICA lodged a bid outside on the final turn and lacked a solid late response. SILVER RAIL always a factor and saving ground, advanced some turning for home then lacked the needed closing response. EFFICIENT FRONTIER raced well placed from the outside until nearing the lane and weakened. SEASIDE DELI prompted the early issue, dropped back rounding the final turn and faded through the lane.
