BORN TO ROYALTY rated off the pace about the four path, started her drive midway on the final turn, dueled clear in the upper stretch, picked up Abyssinian Cat leaving the eighth pole, briefly gave up the lead but regained a slight edge seventy yards out. ABYSSINIAN CAT rated just off the pace inside, altered course three wide at the quarter pole, lost some ground entering the stretch, dueled to a short brief lead at the sixteenth pole but reluctantly yielded the last seventy yards. PAMMIE FROM MIAMI broke just a step slow, settled in unhurriedly saving ground, started her drive into the lane and was along to show. ON MY MIND rated just off the pace in the three path, moved clear nearing the final turn, dueled briefly into the stretch then weakened. HAINT MISBEHAVIN' lost contact early and never factored. ELOQUENTLY never factored. A. P. ACORN set a clear pace inside, faded nearing the final turn then eased through the turn.
