Footnotes

MOETOWN quickly assumed control taking up position toward the rail, was challenged into the stretch, drew clear nearing the eighth pole then widened under aggressive handling. JERSEY A.J. chased the pace from the inside, came off the rail entering the stretch and closed well for place. FAGEDABOUDIT SAL chased the pace from the inside, threatened the winner through the upper stretch but yielded the final furlong. DOWNTHEROADAGAIN chased the pace about the four path and finished evenly. KING'S WHARF chased the early pace toward mid track, saved some ground on the turn then leveled out. GRECIAN KNIGHT showed no speed off the rail, bid angling out at the quarter pole and finished evenly. GREAT GOLD came out slowly, closed widest on the backstretch, was carried wider entering the stretch and empty thereafter. WILKIE'S EMBLEM chased the pace in mid track and weakened into the stretch. ITLLBE ALLRIGHT showed no speed toward the outside, lost some ground entering the stretch and weakened. PARK AVENUE became fractious unseating his rider in the gate and was no factor. MADERO'S BLIZZARD and BLACKOUT O THREE never factored.
