FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination, \$1,500 to pass the entry box with \$150,000 guaranteed, which includes \$25,000 from the Breeders' Cup Fund for Cup nominees only. The host association's money to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Breeders' Cup Fund money correspondingly divided providing a Breeders' Cup nominee finishes in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup Fund money not awarded reverts to the fund. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 at a mile or over in 2007 allowed 2 lbs.; A sweepstakes any time, 4 lbs.; Two races other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs. The winning owner to receive a trophy from Breeders' Cup Limited. Closed Saturday, June 30, 2007 with 15 nominations. \$5,000 supplemental nominations, which include all fees, were made at time of entry, Thursday, July 12, 2007.

Footnotes

FIRST DEFENCE drew clear early and taken under a rating hold, showed the way to the lane and widened slightly in midstretch then was moderately urged while maintaining a safe advantage. GET SERIOUS well placed while saving ground, eased off the inside for the drive and finished willingly while second best. SARATOGA LULABY tracked early outside, was asked on the final turn, lacked the needed response and weakened in the drive. CRUSADER RABBIT in good position outside, was asked for run on the final turn, raced three wide into the lane and lacked the needed response. BRUSH ON BY saved ground into the far turn, eased off the inside, moved back in nearing the quarter pole and lacked a rally. KEENELAND KID raced near the inside and offered little in a dull effort.
