MOSQUITO well placed while saving ground, moved out for the drive, came in slightly nearing the sixteenth pole then proved best. FAGEDABOUDIT SAL set the pace inside, came out slightly nearing the sixteenth pole then held gamely to the wire. BLAZEN lunged out to be away slowly, lodged a three wide bid on the final turn and finished gamely. HARLEQUIN SKY three wide on the clubhouse turn, was asked for run on the final bend and was just off the inside turning for home then finished willingly. THEMANNYTHNLEGEND saved ground and lacked the needed rally. MUSTANG ISLAND tracked early, chased on the final turn, pressed then was in tight between rivals nearing the sixteenth pole and tired. HARBOR RIDGE raced well placed to the far turn and weakened. PRIME OBSESSION raced between foes into the far turn and lacked a bid.
