BEG TO DIFFER broke sharp, was allowed to settle just off ANGELA'S TUNE early, put more pressure on her on the turn while two wide, took command at the quarter pole, poured it on in the stretch and drew clear nicely. MIMI'S GOLDEN GIRL chased three wide early, was roused nicely two wide on the turn, split horses while improving her position three wide into the stretch and rallied to get the place spot. ANGELA'S TUNE held a narrow lead early, was hooked on the final turn by the winner and weakened in the later stages. SO SO KEEN held a forward position three wide early, was just off the leaders three wide on the final turn and hung badly in the stretch. SPECIAL VIRTUE chased four wide early, was aggressively ridden two wide on the turn and made little impact late. REHEARSE was outrun. BASIC INSTINCT offered little in here .
