CASS raced close up inside, advanced on the far turn, came out and wore down REBA'S AFFAIR late. REBA'S AFFAIR stalked the pace, came through on the rail to challenge, took over on the far turn and dug in gamely to the end. OUR GIN MILL outrun early, advanced inside on the far turn, angled out in midstretch and finished well. AQUAPAZZA raced three wide on the first turn, stalked outside, rallied four wide into the stretch and flattened out. BECKY B did not factor. INTROVERT chased three wide and tired. WELL EQUIPPED vied inside for command, drifted off the rail and faded. SWEET DISPOSITION chased outside and gave way.
