SWAY well placed early, lodged a three wide bid on the final turn, was forced a bit wide into the lane and drew clear a furlong out then held a rival safe to the wire. ZULMIN hard held early along the inside, eased out of the final turn, moved five wide entering the stretch and loomed a threat to the top one but could not sustain the needed momentum. STELLA NOVA never far back and off the inside turning for home, offered a mild stretch bid. SICILIAN SOUL prompted the early issue and reached the front into the backstretch, drifted out some into the lane and weakened in the drive. JOAN'S ROSE vied for the early lead, saved ground and had little left entering the lane. HURRICANE NIKKI trailed and just off the inside turning for home, lacked a rally.
