CHEZ LA SAMMANA set the pace on the inside, responded when asked and drew clear under urging. TAKE HER TOTHE TOP raced off the pace, moved up three wide on the far turn and closed well outside. LEONESSA raced off the pace, came four wide into the stretch, closed well and just missed for the place. SUGAR LOVE chased inside, bid three wide on the turn and was outfinished. HULA PARTY had a ground saving trip, drifted in in front of KIM ESQ past midstretch and rallied mildly. MISS BAR A chased outside, bid four wide midway on the far turn and weakened. PLEASANTLY BLONDE settled off the inside and failed to threaten. NEN'S CHOCOLATE saved ground to no avail. WINDY ACRES raced three wide on the backside and did not factor. DIGGIN FASTER pressed the pace, bid between rivals and tired. KIM ESQ raced off the pace, inside in the stretch, clipped heels and broke down at the sixteenth pole. After a Stewards' Inquiry, HULA PARTY was disqualified and placed last for interference past midstretch.
