KNIGHT TRIPP broke alertly and set the early pace, saved ground on the turn and lost the advantage, dueled through the lane then proved best to the wire. IDLE DICE broke a bit slowly, moved up outside and challenged for the lead on the turn, raced head and head passing the quarter pole while being rated then was outfinished by the top one. TUFF TRI broke in, saved ground on the turn, moved out for the drive and chased then lacked the needed late response. PERFECT LOVER broke a bit slowly and near the inside on the turn, chased and raced in the three path entering the lane and lacked the needed stretch response. DISCO JENELLE bumped at the start, saved ground into the turn, was off the inside into the lane and lacked a rally. MO BOURBON PLEASE bumped at the start and in tight early, raced off the inside on the turn and lacked the needed bid. FABS was bumped and steadied while in tight along the inside early dropping back.
