ARCTIC AIR moved out on the turn, raced in the four path into the lane and finished gamely to prevail. HUNG JURY up close early inside, pulled into the turn, raced behind rivals turning for home, split foes a furlong out and reached the front then continued on gamely to the wire. JERSEY KISS moved up four wide on the turn, chased then was best of the rest. RED VOW prompted the early issue, moved to the front briefly between calls on the turn, battled then tired in the drive. SHANKOPOTAMUS set the early pace, saved ground and weakened in the drive. MONTECORE stumbled at the start, advanced three wide and reached the lead passing the quarter pole, battled into midstretch and tired. RAGING SIX raced outside, was six wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. LIVIN LARGE off the inside on the turn, raced five wide into the lane and lacked a bid.
