EMPIRIOR prompted the early issue, moved closer turning for home and dueled through the lane then proved best. CAPTAIN STONE set the pace near the rail, battled through the stretch then yielded grudgingly. UNPRECEDENTED never far back and near the inside turning for home, lacked the needed response. ENCHANTED CIRCLE (GB) well placed and near the rail, moved out for the drive and lacked the needed bid. NARBONA PASS trailed and five wide into the lane, offered a mild stretch gain. SOUPER SPECTACULAR was knocked sideways leaving the gate, raced just off the inside into the far turn and lacked the needed response when asked. CAPITAL MARKET broke a bit slowly, raced well placed while three wide into the far turn, moved in and weakened. VINNIE stumbled badly at the start coming inward and impeding a rival, moved up inside and challenged briefly on the backstretch then gradually tired. The stewards posted the inquiry sign concerning the start prior to declaring the original order of finish official.
