Footnotes

SAINT DYNAFORMER settled off the rail, three wide on the backside, rallied three wide into the stretch, battled it out with the runner up and prevailed. BERNIE'S SURPRISE pulled along the first turn, tracked inside, angled off the rail approaching the stretch, bid between rivals and dug in gamely to the wire. VIOLATOR raced off the pace, came three wide into the lane and made a late run outside. PIANO RED raced off the pace, angled out at the top of the lane and rallied outside. ALBANY ROAD raced off the pace inside, was steadied at the quarter pole, raced between rivals in midstretch and lacked a winning bid. MILL BAY steadied leaving the clubhouse turn, raced between rivals, came three wide into the stretch and lacked a late response. BARBERSHOP saved ground on the far turn, angled out and gained mildly between foes. SCAVEZZATO chased three wide, steadied in traffic at the quarter pole and weakened. JEAN'S MARQ set the pace and tired in the final furlong. AIDAN'S SLEW stalked and tired.
