GOOSEY GANDER well placed while saving ground, joined the leaders in upper stretch and finished well while edging clear at the wire. NOTEABLE saved ground while setting the pace, raced off the rail into the lane and continued on gamely to the wire. WON JENELLE always a factor, challenged for the lead three deep on the final turn, loomed a solid threat into midstretch but was not good enough. ONCE AROUND saved ground into the far turn, eased out nearing the top of the lane and lacked the needed stretch response. STRODES LANE restrained early while along the inside, raced four wide turning for home and lacked the needed rally. MINER'S CLEMENTINE hesitated some at the start to be away slowly, saved ground and lacked a bid. PICNIC THEME pressed the early issue and weakened through the lane.
