KANSAS CITY BOY settled in just off the rail through the backstretch, angled four wide making his bid on the final turn then edged clear under a firm rein to win handily. LEADING THE PARADE, unhurried inside, started his bid into the final turn, angled widest looking for room through the upper stretch, got up late for place and finished well. LITTLE DOVEFEATHER rated back from the early pace two deep, advanced to a short lead three wide leaving the quarter pole then duelled close to midstretch before beginning to weaken. ENROUTE rated off the early pace inside, bid off the rail on the final turn, duelled to midstretch and weakened from there. MONSTER AFFAIR chased the pace toward the outside and weakened through the final turn. TRANSIT OF VENUS pulled himself to a long clear lead while firmly under wraps, was pressured nearing the quarter pole and gave way into the stretch.
