### Footnotes

DANCE OF JEWELS saved ground off the pace, angled out at the top of the lane, rallied three wide, drew clear past the furlong marker and held on. SKIP AWAY BELLE raced three wide early, settled off the rail, bid three wide at the quarter pole, led into the lane, angled out past the sixteenth marker and came again late. RIGHT NICE PHILLY raced four wide early, stalked outside, moved up nearing the far turn and finished evenly. SOUTHERN OAKS was away alertly, set the pace and weakened. FLIP THE COIN saved ground, angled out on the far turn, came wide and lacked a winning bid. ALL BETS OFF raced between rivals, was steadied at the five sixteenths pole and then failed to threaten. BATTERY OPERATED dropped back early.
