MR J tracked inside, raced in the two path turning for home, ran down the leader and drew clear. GO BERNIE GO stalked two wide, bid on the backside, shook clear on the far turn and was all out to save the place. DIXIE SUN raced off the pace and closed belatedly between rivals. GLOBAL ASSET raced off the pace, angled out and closed belatedly outside. COOL COLONY set the pace, dueled inside and weakened. TAPERRIFIC chased outside a rival, came three wide into the lane and closed belatedly outside. QUIET DANGER raced off the pace and failed to threaten. DROP THE GUN was outrun.
