FAVORITE SWEEP four wide into the turn, advanced three deep on the bend and challenged for the lead, dueled into midstretch and drew clear. BEAT THE CHALK reached the front along the inside approaching the half mile pole, saved ground and battled into midstretch then was no match while second best. GOLDEN GATOR between foes on the backstretch, chased and lacked the needed stretch response. HAIACCEPT came out nearing the half mile pole, moved out for the drive and lacked a solid response. RAT LIKE CUNNING raced in close nearing the half mile pole then lacked a response. LEAD BY EXAMPLE in tight between rivals, clipped heels nearing the half mile pole dropping back. COUNT MONTBROOK vied for the early lead, remained a factor to the lane and weakened. Following a stewards inquiry, HAIACCEPT was disqualified from fourth and placed sixth for backstretch interference.
