Footnotes

HARD ENOUGH tracked early, bid on the final turn, raced in the three path into the lane and responded to left handed pressure while edging clear. REPORTING STAR never far back and three wide into the stretch, finished willingly. SHINING COPPER set the pace, raced just off the rail turning for home and continued on willingly to the wire while not good enough. VEGAS NO SHOW saved ground while well placed, bid along the rail then lacked the needed late response. GUN POINT saved ground early, was just off the inside turning for home and lacked the needed response. SHARP OMAR broke out, raced three wide on the clubhouse turn and needed a rally. KEEP THE CANOLI trailed, saved ground and lacked the needed stretch response. ENGLISH MINISTER between rivals the majority of the race, was three wide into the lane and offered little in the drive. GOLDEN JASON forwardly placed early, chased on the final turn, was four wide into the stretch and tired.
