Footnotes

CUT NUMBER stalked the early leader, moved to the front nearing the top of the lane then drew off, driving. SECRET TERMS well placed early from the outside, was asked on the final turn then got up late for the place. FOR PETER'S SAKE rank rounding the clubhouse turn, saved ground while setting the pace and weakened in the drive. STACK FAMA trailed early, advanced outside on the final turn and offered a mild stretch gain. AWAY TO GO well placed early, raced just off the rail and had little left entering the lane. LADY KREW saved ground into the far turn, moved out and lacked a bid. MY CHER lacked a response. SIGNAL TAPPER saved ground while close up early and tired. STORYVILLE GIRL a bit reluctant to load and hung a bit wide into the clubhouse turn, stayed outside and gave way on the final turn.
