COOL ARIA showed the way to the lane, raced removed from the rail into the stretch then maintained a clear margin to the wire while racing a bit erratically through the final furlong. PRIME COMMANDER eased out while moving nearing the top of the lane then finished well. LEGITIMADA (ARG) saved ground while chasing the early pace, eased out some on the final turn, moved back inside for the drive and lacked a solid closing response. FAIRLY WELL TUNED raced just off the rail rounding the final turn and lacked the needed late response. SKIP TRIAL MISS well placed and four deep into the far turn, tired in the drive. GOOMADA BYDA SEA stumbled leaving the gate, saved ground on the final turn and lacked the needed bid. PRESTIGIOUS PRIZE in good position to the far turn, weakened. MADISON HALEE lacked a rally. JUDITH'S ROAD vied for the early lead, remained a factor into the far turn and gradually gave way.
